

Computing Setting for Seniors Vista/7

Change the size on the Active Border, Scale up DPI

1. On an open Desktop area
2. Right Click >**Personalize**
3. Click on **Windows Color and Appearance**
4. Click on **Display**
5. Set to “**Large - 150%**” or **set custom DPI**.

Screen Resolution

1. On Desktop area
2. Right-Click>**Personalize**.
3. Select Display Settings, Windows 7: Click **Adjust resolution**
Slide the Resolution button to the left to lower it.

* The lower the large icons and text will appear.

Disable Transparency

1. On an open Desktop area
2. Right Click >**Personalize**
3. Click on **Windows Color**
4. Uncheck “**Enable transparency**”
5. Increase “**Color intensity**”

Make the Mouse Pointer Larger

1. On Desktop area
2. Right-Click>**Personalize**.
3. Select **Mouse Pointers** tab
4. Select the desired Windows Standard extra large scheme
5. Click **OK**.

Mouse Double-Click Speed

1. Click on the **Buttons** tab.
2. Click and drag on the slider button under **Double-click speed**
3. Test it using the folder icon to open and close

Mouse Pointer Speed

1. Click on the **Pointer Options** tab.
2. Click and drag on the slider under **pointer speed**.
3. Click **Apply** to test.

Large Icons

1. On Desktop area
2. Right-Click>**View**.
3. Select Large Icons.
